# POSSIBLE HAZZARDS



- ❖ The Main Street of Shiremanstown does permit the carrying of hazardous materials including gasoline and oil tanker trucks.
- ❖ There is a storage field of several gasoline tanks within a mile west of this location on Simpson Ferry Road (Main Street, Shiremanstown).
- ❖ There is also an active railroad running east-west, within 100 yards of the northern property line of this building. A variety of rail cars travel this line, including petroleum, chlorides, and other hazardous materials.
- ❖ Just beyond the rail road is the old Quaker & Purina plants. These facilities are currently being used as truck terminals for Arnold Logistics and others. It is unknown if any manufacturing is still occurring but it is assumed that there is hazardous materials in this location and could be transported by trucks on site and on the connecting roads to and from this site.

# MORE POSSIBLE HAZARDS



- ❖ There are utilities which run over head and underground down Main Street as well as Strawberry Alley, the road between the church building and the Fellowship Center. These include high voltage electric, water, and natural gas lines, each of which could cause an emergency if disruption should occur.
- ❖ The facility is susceptible to inclement weather conditions such as blizzard, severe thunder and lightening storms, hail, and possible hurricanes.
- ❖ The building is susceptible to fire, water or electrical hazards within the facility.
- ❖ Another type of emergency may be from an intruder.
